The GSCDST provides a wide range of services including:

- one to one counselling for individuals and families
- counselling for people in the justice system, including court diversion programs
- drug and alcohol withdrawal management
- information about drugs and alcohol
- education and training for professionals and community groups
- support and consultation to schools, service providers and community groups
- A family program (YAP) to help families who are experiencing drug and alcohol problems
- needle and syringe program
- Group counselling and art therapy
